## Artwork statement

The ensemble of six sculptures symbolises a renewal of past, present and future growth and change.

Inspired by earth and water formations, the hardwood columns and sandstone slabs evoke a timeless and ancient space, only recently witnessing the Caboolture campus being built on the weathered sandstone bedrock below.

The title also refers to the human qualities of a questioning mind and achieving spirit. Pinnacles and Reflections create a sense of place where our dreaming is grounded and connected by natural materials.
