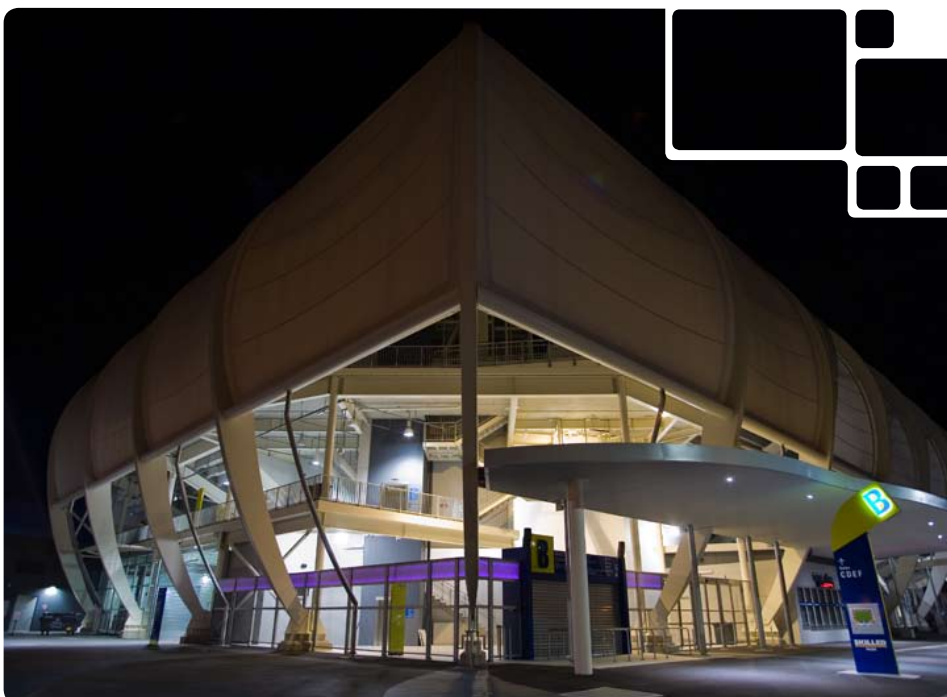
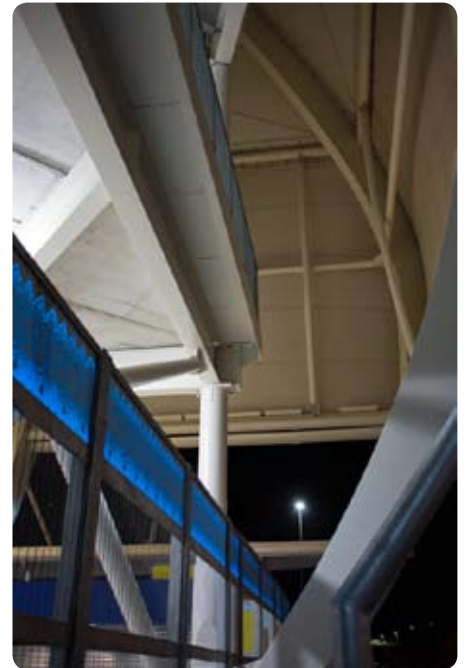

The work responds to the idiom of expressing the uplifting joys of success, victory and sporting mateship. The work anoints the entry fence with an imaginary crown, a beautiful filigree border of perforated metal sheeting internally lit. The LED lighting within moves through a myriad of colours reflecting the excitement and spectacle of a game - in so doing becoming the stadium's 'Crowning Glory'.

Artwork statement

Three distinct designs, Words, Streamers, and Tactics, are etched into various concrete cube bollards, situated around the stadium. Each one represents the various components associated with the life and vigour of the sports arena.

Words – Sourced from the promotion and media component of the sports world. The principal intent was to find interesting shapes.

Streamers – Represents the audience, the fans and the excitement of sports events.

Tactics – Represents the players, coaches, preparation and execution of the game.
